*Performing well from bottle, Chateau Margaux's 2002 is an elegant seamlessly constructed effort with a deep ruby / purple colour, and beautiful nose of flowers, crème de cassis blackberries and cedar. One of the most elegant wine of the vintage and drinkable young. Drink 2005 – 20. 93 Parker Points*

**B. Chateau Baron Pichon Longueville Grand Cru Pauillac 1998 13%Vol. £120.00**

*Dense purple, 1998 Pichon Baron offers up a sweet bouquet of liquorice, smoke asphalt blackberries, and crème de cassis. Elegant rather than full-blown, with medium body, sweet fruit, nice texture and mid-pallet with moderate tannin. 93 Parker Points*

**C. Baron Mouton Rothschild 1er Cru Classe Pauillac 1999, 12.5% Vol. £285.00**

*A blend of Cabernet Sauv., Merlot and some Cab. Franc. Opaque coloured, chunky with finesse and stature. It offers a tell-tale cassis scented nose and a monolithic, medium to full bodied style with relatively high austere tannin. 90 Parker Points.*

**D. Pommard Clos de la Pourtiere 1er Cru - Bouchard 1990, 13.5% Vol. £99.00**

*From the famous vineyard of Bouchard, medium to dark ruby colour and powerful, red fruit scented and flavoured wine. Big, broad, and crammed with red cherries, velvety textured with some spice. 90 Parker Points*

**E. Chevaliere Montrachet Grand Cru – Bouchard 1989, 13.5% Vol. £170.00**

*An absolutely stunning wine, with profound aromas of baked white fruits and stones. On the palate it is offering tell-tale richness. Waves of deeply ripe pears, apples, nuts and traces of peach bits. Complex and velvety textured. 91 Parker Points*

**The Goose' Wines** - The Upper Langkloof Appellation is arguably the coldest wine growing region in South Africa. These extreme climatic conditions ensure complexity of fruit and unique grapes that are handcrafted into world - class wines. After hand harvesting the grapes are transported to cool-rooms, where

the temperature is maintained at 4 degrees Celsius for 12 hour to cool the grapes.

Upon arrival at the cellar the cold grapes are sorted before being crushed and pumped into open cement troughs. There the juice is allowed to ferment on the skin cap for eight to fourteen days, extracting the vital character and colour from the skins into the wine as it develops. Malolactic fermentation completed in imported French barrels.

'The Goose' is styled into classic and elegantly structured wine by ageing it in these barrels for a further eighteen to twenty-four month. 'The Goose' Expression 2005 is a 50% Cabernet Sauvignon and 50% Shiraz blend.

The prominent Shiraz ensures herbaceous tones and white pepper flavours which fuse with the soft, blackberry undertones of the Cabernet Sauvignon.

This is a truly a new-world blend, that achieves the much sought after, traditional old-world balance and elegance.
